It includes passing qualifying courses of Physics, Biology, Chemistry and Mathematics that are given by the university with a grade not less than "D" , or passing the required EMSAT exams with a score of 800 or its equivalent.

- The grade averages above represent the minimum required for admission to the University. Please note that students meeting the above average requirements are not guarantee admission but fall subject to competitive regulations and standards.

Additional Fees:

- Application fee: 360 AED (Non-refundable).
- Student ID card fees: 105 AED (Valid for 4 years).

Notes:

- Semester tuition fees are applied to students registered for (12) credit hours, who may increase their credit hours up to (16) at the same semester tuition rate.
- Tuition fees for students registered for less than (12) credit hours are calculated according to the rate per credit hour for each of the colleges.
- Tuition fees for students registered for more than (16) credit hours are calculated by applying the approved credit hour rate for credit hours exceeding 16.
- Excluded from these policies are students in the Colleges of Medicine, and Dental Medicine for which annual tuition fees are applied.
- The University of Sharjah reserve the right to increase the fees every year.
